ECOmmunity Place Heritage Tours offers a variety of customized tours



General Walkabouts:

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides and/or the Traditional Ecological Knowledgekeeper (TEK) will lead you on an interpretive tour, answer questions and provide you with information about the general area and habitat of the "Cottonwood Riparian" ecosystem.



Bird watching:

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK lead numerous bird watching expeditions where participants will identify and photograph the bird population of the "Cottonwood Riparian" ecosystem and log all relevant information about each sighting.



Plant Identification:

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK will guide you on an interpretive expedition to identify the local plant species, provide information and answer any questions. Participants will identify them as foreign or indigenous plants to the area, describe the common uses and identify special attributes and special uses of each plant.



Reptile Identification:

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK will lead you on an interactive tour where you will search for, identify and photograph the reptilian population of the "Cottonwood Riparian" ecosystem.



Species at Risk identification:

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK leads an informative tour where you search for, identify, photograph and log any relevant information about the Species at Risk and/ or the Endangered Species while touring the ECOmmunity Place.



Cultural Tours

ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK will bring you to the ECOmmunity Place Locatee Lands so they can share cultural information, stories and/ or songs. ECOmmunity Interpretive Tour Guides/ TEK leads tours where they will help you identify the culturally significant species or areas which are within ECOmmunity Place lands.

PLEASE NOTE:

Daily tours (General Walkabout) are Wednesday to Friday starting at 9:00am, meet Interpreters at the En'owkin Centre, then drive your vehicles to the Locatee Lands. Specialty programs/ tours (Bird watching, Reptile ID...) are scheduled programs hosted by ECOmmunity Place and must be arranged (or booked) in advance. For your comfort we ask that you wear comfortable shoes & a hat. Also, that you bring water/ beverage, insect repellent, a sweater/ longsleeve. Cameras are welcome.
