

Job Title: nsyilxcn Language Planning Coordinator

Job Summary: Over the course of the project term, the nsyilxcn Language Planning Coordinator (NLPC) will coordinate meetings with nsyilxcn communities to develop an nsyilxcn language revitalization plan. The NLPC will develop and implement a language survey in the area and coordinate, facilitate, and implement language planning initiatives based on the results. The NLPC will liaise between collaborating syilx communities and will work closely with community representatives to build and strengthen collaborative relationships and establish practices for communication and sharing.

Employment: Contract, Full Time (35 hours per week)

Contract: April 2026 – March 31, 2027

Key Responsibilities:

- Survey area to identify language needs and language speakers' resources
- Establish relations with language speakers
- Coordinate language planning satellite initiatives for the community
- Work closely with representatives from the community to implement language planning initiatives
- Coordinate and facilitate language planning meetings with representatives from the collaborating communities
- Draft a language vision statement that represents the goals and visions for the language shared by collaborating communities
- Coordinate and facilitate community-wide language planning mobilization meetings
- Work with the community to create language resources to promote fluency
- Draft a Language Revitalization Plan: using information and knowledge gathered from the meetings and the language assessment survey, and taking into account the various needs and priorities of each collaborating community, work together with community representatives to guide current and future language revitalization initiatives
- Assist in completing the reporting requirements to the FPCC
- Work with proven programming provided by the FPCC to determine the best course of action to create a language base
- Collaborate with the local community and language speakers to create programming that supports the development of fluent language speakers

- Ability to travel between communities as necessary
- Knowledge of the syilx language
- Criminal Record Check and valid Drivers Licence
