The main goal of her research is to create impactful, equitable, and sustainable health-land-focused reconciliation efforts guided by Indigenous knowledge systems. Her M.A. focused on the significant role of Cree Storytelling in preserving community knowledge through cultural-traditional artistic expressions. Being an English speaker, Geraldine deeply values learning the Cree language and teachings from Cree Elders. Before academia, Geraldine worked extensively with Indigenous communities and organizations, honouring community-driven approaches guided by Indigenous protocols and leadership.**
